

9TH INTERNATIONAL MINIATURE BIENNALE – "Józef Czapski – a witness of history" Regulations

Honorary patronage: The Minister of Culture, National Heritage and Sport of the Republic of Poland

Organizers: Centrum Edukacji Artystycznej (The Center of Artistic Education),

Liceum Sztuk Plastycznych we Włocławku (The High School of Fine Arts in Włocławek)

Aims:

Getting to know about the history of life and works of art of Józef Czapski .

The organizers of the competition assume that the Biennale is an excellent opportunity to present creative achievements in the field of painting, graphics, textile art and small forms of sculpture.

Conditions of participation:

The competition is open for students of art schools and art institutions aged 12 to 20.

Art works in the field of painting, graphics, textiles and sculptures inspired by the works of Józef Czapski – a painter, a writer and a Soviet camp inmate - can be sent to the Biennale. Each participant may submit up to 3 works. Maximum size of works 200 x 200 x 200 mm. No limitations in technique.

The works must have the author's emblem and the country of origin placed to the reverse (the emblem should be in the form of Latin text, letters or numbers, not a graphic symbol) and a closed envelope with the same emblem attached to each work; inside the envelope you should put the completed Attachment No.1. The schools sending students' works are requested to send at the same time the list of participants.

The opening of the post-competition exhibition with awards and distinctions will be held on 8th June, 2026.

The Minister of Culture and National Heritage will appoint a jury, consisting of representatives of art schools, to evaluate the works and allocate prizes.

Rating criteria:

- accordance with the topic

- the statutory format of the work
- author's concept
- interesting compositional solutions and correctness; the use of artistic means adequate to the subject of the work
- appropriate framing - not colliding with the character of artworks - within the format 200 x 200 x 200 mm.

Final Provisions:

The organizer is not responsible for damage caused during postal transport. The submitted works are non-returnable and they will be a part of the competition organizer's collection.

Each participant will receive the Biennale catalogue.
